Staffing:

ECO team:

Our Eco team, shared their action plans in an assembly before the end of last term. One of their actions was to reduce litter in the school, in their meeting they chose and ordered new school bins. These are now visible in the playground – we've had lots of positive feedback about them. The aim is to make sure they are well used!



United Nations Convention on the Rights of a Child (UNCRC)

Rights Respecting Schools' Award – we are in the process of registering for the Bronze award and are highlighting and discussing the rights children have under this Convention. Last week we held an assembly based upon Article 19 – '*I have the right to be protected from being hurt or badly treated*'. You will get more information about the UNCRC soon and will be asked to complete a short survey. Please look out for it – your opinions matter and your responses will be used to indicate our starting points as a school.

Parent Survey

We formally survey parents every two years to gain feedback on what the school is doing well and address areas that could be developed/improved.
