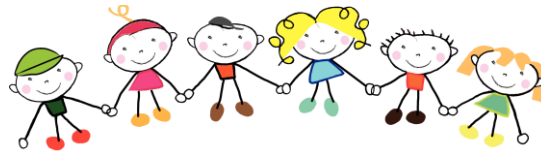

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be learning to...

Adapt our behaviour to changes in familiar routines and new situations.

Show awareness of the feelings of others and how they might be feeling.

Confidently initiate play with other children.

Understand the consequences of our actions.

Demonstrate friendly behaviour with others and help our friends.

Communication & Language

We will be learning to...

Talk about an experience or event using past, present and future tenses more accurately.

Focus attention for longer periods of time when listening.

Answer simple questions about stories and offer explanations.

Retell simple stories.

Follow instructions without visual clues

Physical Development

We will be learning to...

Put our coats, shoes and socks on independently

Observe the effects of activity on our bodies.

Move with confidence in a range of ways, negotiating space.

Use one handed tools and equipment with increasing control, including pencils and scissors.

Forming letter shapes.

Literacy

We will be learning to...

Hear and say some letter sounds.

Use groups of letters or letter-like shapes when writing.

Write our name and other familiar words.

Link letter sounds to letter shapes.

Identify the main characters and setting of a story.

Mathematics

We will be learning to...

Make comparisons between different quantities.

Separate a group of objects into groups, recognising that the total is still the same.

Use graphic representation to record number explorations in pictures and mark making.

Name simple 2D shapes in play.

Expressive Arts & Design

We will be learning to...

Use dance, songs, colour and sounds, construction, role play and imaginative play to express ideas.

Experience and describe the texture of items.

Building stories around toys.

Enclose shapes when drawing and painting to represent objects.

Understanding the World

We will be learning to...

Talk about how and why things work.

Show care and concern for living things and the environment.

Use technologies to share experiences with others and share experiences of using technology.

Say what makes each of us unique and special.

- Involving them in simple tasks at home like sorting the matching socks or working out the number of plates needed for setting the table
