P.E. Days:

Tuesday and Friday

Come to school dressed in PE kit and on Friday bring a bag with swimming costume, towel, hat and goggles.

You can help your child to succeed by doing the following:

Listen to your child read and sign the Homework Diary. When listening to your child read, please ask questions to ensure understanding of the text. Help your child to learn the weekly spellings. Help your child to learn the times tables.

This term our learning will be based around the theme of 'Flight' We will learn about the history, nature and mythology of flight. We will study flying animals and learn about human flying machines such as aeroplanes and drones.

Maths: We will practise the 4 operations, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division alongside shape, measure and statistics work. Each week will end with a 'Prove it' activity to assess understanding and a pre-assessment task for the following week's learning targets.

English: Much of the literacy work will be linked to the topics being taught in class. We will cover: reading, spellings, handwriting, composition, vocabulary, grammar and punctuation. Each writing 'genre' that is taught will start with a 'cold write' and end with a 'hot write' to show progress. Focus texts: Fantastic Mr Fox by Roald Dahl and Soar Elinor! by Tami Lewis Brown

Science: States of Matter i.e. evaporation, condensation, melting and freezing and the water cycle. Science Enquiry Skills: Designing and carrying out investigations into flight.

Art, Design and Technology: Creating picture frames for summer fayre, Parish in Bloom art competition, photo collage and design and build flying machines.

Geography: To tie in with the flight topic: Mapping and aerial perspectives; bird migration routes; aeroplane destinations.

History: To tie in with flight topic: The history of aviation.

PE: On Tuesday with our Sports Coach Keiron and on Friday at Langford swimming pool.

Computing: Create and use spreadsheets, create multimedia presentations, and stay safe online.

Music: Compose and perform melodies and rhythms using instruments and voices.

PSHE: 'Relationships' and 'Changing Me' plus regular Class Council meetings and activities to develop positive 'learner traits' such as resilience, curiosity and co-operation.

French: Conversational French – Speak in sentences using familiar vocabulary, phrases and basic language structures.
