This term our learning will be based around the theme of
'Fairy Tales!'

Children will learn about the following...

Personal, Social and Emotional Development: We will be continuing to learn about how to be a good friend, families and what changes we might see as our bodies grow. Our Jigsaw topics are: Friendships and Changing Me.

Communication and Language: Turn taking in conversation, using talk to share ideas, feelings and events and thinking of their own Helicopter stories where they are acted out with the whole class.

Physical Development: continuing to form most of our letters correctly, attempting to write labels and captions in their play and short sentences with adult support. We are continuing to discuss healthy and unhealthy foods.

Literacy: Reading simple 3 and 4 letter words e.g. cat, mat, tree, and recognising sight words confidently (words on their rockets) as well as answering questions about the book.

Maths: We are continuing to learn simple addition and subtraction up to 20, recording our numbers on whiteboards, doubling and halving numbers and talking about the features of 2D and 3D shapes.

Understanding the world: We are learning about plants and animals. We will be planting beans, looking after our plant and observing the changes like 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.

Expressive Arts and Design: Using colours appropriately, keeping a beat with instruments and reviewing our creations and taking the next steps.

You can help your child to succeed by doing the following:

- Reading daily
- Practicing their sound fans and rockets each week
- Encouraging your child to help to write the shopping list, cards, or a comment about their picture using their sounds
- Going to the park, library, beach and woods
- Talking about what you are doing and asking questions about what you have done
