This term our learning will be based around the theme of

'The Adventures of Sherlock Holmes'

Pupils will learn about the following...

Maths: Translation and reflection of shapes, reading and interpreting information in tables, including timetables, revising addition, subtraction, multiplication and division strategies and applying these to problem solving, understanding percentage and using this for calculations and statistic work.

English: English and guided reading will often be linked to focus text Sherlock Holmes. We will also be looking at the structure and features of letters, newspaper reports and diaries.

Focus text: 'The Adventures of Sherlock Holmes' retold from the Sir Arthur Conan Doyle original.

Science: Animal life cycles and the differences between these. Plant life cycles and plant reproduction. Human life cycles. In the final half term lessons will focus on sex education. More information will follow.

Geography:**Art/DT:**

PE: All pupils will be learning about athletics and batting and fielding games such as kwikcricket or rounders.

Music: Pupils will study a range of styles and genres and musically draw together listening/appraising, composing/improvising and performing skills.

PSHE: Relationships – exploring the importance of relationships and friendships amongst family and peers. Changing Me – exploring the changes that occur in a growing body. Pupils will also be looking at transition to secondary school.

Computing: Pupils will continue to build upon their knowledge of E-Safety as well as learning more about online communication such as how to use school email alongside Office 365.

French: Salut Jersey Troisieme Partie.
