Staffing:

ECO team – Safe Routes to school; We NEED your help:

Our Eco team recently met with Deputy Kevin Pamplin and a number of them walked to school along Bagatelle Road. Parents, pupils and the wider school community have serious concerns about safety when walking this route, particularly at the busy crossing points. We are hoping to work more closely with the Parish and other schools as well as the Government of Jersey on this significant issue. In order to gather information to support this work, we have compiled a short survey which we hope you can complete for us.

We are really excited to be holding our next focus week during the week before half term and this term we will be developing our STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) skills. We are delighted that a number of local engineers will be spending time in classes within school to support pupils in the designing, creating and evaluating. All classes from Nursery to Year 6 will be involved and the project theme will be 'Moving vehicles'. You will be given class specific information nearer the time but we wanted you to know that we will be holding a showcase event on Friday 14th February from 2pm – this will be a parent sharing session to view and learn more about the skills the pupils have developed during the week. We really hope you will be able to join us for this session or part of it. Nursery parents will have a session at a different time to support those pupils who attend during the morning only sessions.
