As part of our new topic, please complete as many of these tasks over the Summer term as home learning. Hopefully if the lifting of restrictions allow, our 'fabulous finish' of designing, creating and exploding our own volcanoes will take place later in the term.

We recognise there have been many levels of participation to date and understand that sometimes it's difficult to complete all activities at home. Thank you to those pupils and families that have taken time and care over the quality of learning so far.

There will be some changes to the dojo's awarded for this term;

Each task completed = a range of dojo points awarded, depending on presentation and time taken over a task. There will be additional dojo points for effort, presentation and creativity too.

Watch the following videos about the impact of volcanoes from the text 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balit and the song/story 'Lava' about the volcanoes from 'Moana'. These will help a lot of our learning when we return to school.

- Draw a picture of a volcano scene
- Write an acrostic poem using the letters from the word 'VOLCANO'
- Create a word search using topic words.
- Fact page about volcanoes or Pompeii
- Write instructions for how to create a model volcano
- Research the benefits of living near a volcano
- Write an explanation about how volcanoes form / erupt
- Write an A-Z list of adjectives (or other words) you could use to describe a volcano
- Write 10 questions you would like to ask someone who witnessed Vesuvius erupt
- Draw a map showing the location of volcanic eruptions around the world
- Make a working volcano model with labels / explanation of how it works
- Fact book about volcanoes/ Pompeii with a front cover, contents page, information on at least 3 topics in your own words, pictures and a glossary
- Design a volcano survival kit with diagrams, labels and an explanation of how it works

- Make a 3D volcano model
- Create 'Top Trump' cards for volcanoes around the world
- Write an adventure story set around a volcanic eruption / Pompeii
- Write a diary of someone living near a volcano
- Research and present findings in your own words on the 'The Ring of Fire'
- Write an interview of questions and answers with someone who saw Vesuvius erupt
- Create an advice leaflet outlining what to do should a volcano erupt
- Research and present findings in your own words about different types of volcanoes
- Make a 3D model of a typical Roman building that you might have found in Pompeii
- Design a tourist leaflet encouraging people to visit Naples, Vesuvius and/or Pompeii
- Write a newspaper report about a volcanic eruption in Pompeii including a headline, paragraphs, pictures and quotes from witnesses
- Create a board game using your new knowledge of volcanoes
