Seesaw: Home learning through Seesaw. Four activities will be uploaded per day including maths, writing, reading and a topic/creative based activity.

Reading: Pupils should be reading for 15 minutes at least 5 times a week. This needs to be recorded in their reading record every night and to be signed by an adult once a week. sign their reading diary. Pupils need to bring their records in on a Thursday to be checked. Pupils can also access Rapid Readers on Active Learn.

Spellings: Year 6 statutory spellings are in the front of the pupil's green homework book to be learnt and practised throughout the year.

Maths: Practising times tables using Times Tables Rockstars and use of the Active Learn login for all maths learning we have been doing.

P.E. Days: Monday and Wednesday
Come to school dressed in PE kit (when school resumes).

Parent sharing session: Year 6 Leavers Assembly– date/time: tbc

This term our learning will be based around the theme of
'The Neolithic Era'

Children will learn about the following...

Maths: Mathematical reasoning to investigate and solve problems as well as estimating and predicting. Pupils will also revise and consolidate the four main operations alongside fractions and shape.

English: Some English will be linked to the topic. Developing a detailed character description for the main character 'Tenko' from our class text. Pupils will be looking at the structure and features of information text and create a 'Survival Guide to Year 6,' as well as completing a short individual year book project reflecting on their time here at St Saviour's School.

Focus class text: 'The Boy with the Bronze Axe' By Kathleen Fidler.

Science: Animals including humans - recognise the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on the way their bodies function.

History: The Neolithic era – prehistoric Jersey (La Hougue Bie and dolmens)

Computing: Staying safe online and using a variety of programs to create presentations incorporating a range of media.

PE: All pupils will be learning about athletics and batting and fielding games such as kwicricket or rounders.

Music: Charanga - Reflect, Rewind and Replay.

PSHE: Relationships – exploring the importance of relationships and friendships amongst family and peers. Changing Me – exploring the changes that occur in a growing body. Pupils will also be looking at transition to secondary school.

Art/ DT: Neolithic style cave painting and designing, making & evaluating Neolithic huts, tools and weapons.

French: Revision of Salut Jersey Part Deux.

You can help your child to succeed by doing the following daily:

- Listen to/encourage your child to read.
- Practise quick recall of times tables and division facts.
- Support and encourage your child to become independent and take ownership of their own learning and personal organisation.
