Parent/Carer.....

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
- If my child, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately;
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the latest physical distancing rules.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child;
- When dropping off and picking up only I adult will accompany my child;
- My child will not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school unless agreed with the class teacher;
- My child may have their temperature taken on arrival and during the day if they feel or present as being unwell
- I will need to remind my child about physical distancing rules with adults but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child may not always do this successfully
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre-arranged appointment – I will make appointments via telephone or email;
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis;
- Read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details.
- If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

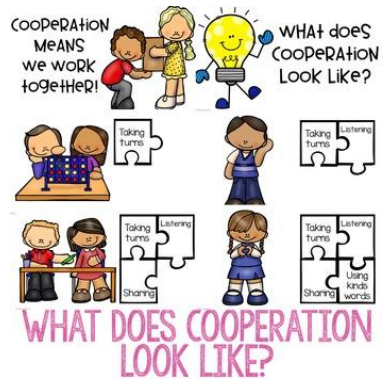
