Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to our latest newsletter of the Summer Term. It has been a very busy couple of weeks and I'd like to thank you for bearing with us and your understanding of the situation in school due to the positive Covid-19 cases we have had. So far, we have not had any notification of any cases that have been caught or spread within school, which is reassuring and shows the systems and procedures we have in place are effective in reducing the spread of the virus. We have put additional cleaning procedures in place which include a daily cleaner employed within the school during the school day to clean touchpoints, surfaces and the entire school building.
