Staggered starts and class bubble arrangements

With the current guidelines for class bubbles and staggered starts not changing, I am writing to confirm our current arrangements for when the school reopens for the Autumn Term. All pupils from Years 1 to Year 6 will be returning on Monday 6th September. Nursery and Reception pupils have had letters to inform them of their starting arrangements.

Years 1, 2 and Reception will enter and access ONLY through the rear gate on Chasse Brunet. Years 3 and 4 will enter ONLY through the front gate and the main entrance and Year 5 and 6 will enter ONLY through the garden at the front building. Nursery will continue to use their own entrance.
