building. Please enter and exit through the school front door only. Mrs Jones and I will welcome you and direct you to the classrooms. For Nursery appointments, please enter through the Nursery as usual and for Reception parents please enter through the Reception gate in the playground.

URGENT - SCHOOL BAGS: Following my writing to you over the last year about school bags, we continue to have a number of pupils bringing bags to school. Please support us with this request for pupils to only bring a coat, hat, book bag and lunchbox to school, most pupils bring their drink bottle with their lunchbag. In April, we had a Fire audit with UK experts and they highlighted safety concerns around the use of cloakroom spaces and storage of items within school. To address highlighted concerns, we are in the process of purchasing coat trolleys for each class.



These coat trolleys will be stored in/just outside classrooms and do not have the capacity for all pupils to bring a bag – we understand that on some days, according to after-school arrangements, some pupils will need to bring a bag in with them. We will have space for the odd bag in these circumstances. Larger bookbags are available from our uniform stockists, these will accommodate hats, thin coats and water bottles.

PTA News – Sadly, due to a range of circumstances the PTA as a group are disbanding at this time. We thank all parents, families and friends for their support of recent events and initiatives and we look forward to working closely with some volunteers for events in the future.
