Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be learning to...

- Separate confidently from our Parent/Carer in the morning
- Form good relationships with peers and familiar adults
- Select and use activities and resources with help
- Take turns and share resources with support

Communication & Language

We will be learning to...

- Follow directions
- Listen to others one to one or in small groups
- Use more complex sentences to link thoughts
- Retell a simple past event in the correct order

Physical Development

We will be learning to...

- Tell adults when hungry or tired
- Manage washing and drying our hands independently
- Understand that equipment and tools have to be used safely
- Put our coats and shoes on independently
- Catch a ball
- Draw lines and circles using gross motor movements
- Hold a pencil between thumb and two fingers

Literacy

We will be learning to...

- Look at books independently
- Hold books the correct way up and turn pages carefully
- Show interest in illustrations
- Give meaning to marks when drawing and painting
- Recognise our name and ascribe meaning to marks seen in different places

Mathematics

We will be learning to...

- Show an interest in shape and space by playing with shapes or making arrangements with objects
- Use number names and number language during our play
- Recite numbers 1-10
- Use positional language

Expressive Arts & Design

We will be learning to...

- Sing a few familiar songs
- Tap out simple repeated rhythms
- Create movement in response to music
- Notice what adults do, imitating what is observed and then doing it spontaneously when the adult is not there
- Join in circle games

Understanding the World

We will be learning to...

- Show an interest in the lives of people familiar to you
- Show an interest in different occupations
- Operate simple equipment, e.g. remote control toys.

Reminders:

- Waterproof coat everyday
- **Name** all items of clothing including school shoes.
- Sun hat and apply sunscreen before school on the high UV days
- Family photos if not already in
- Named water bottle and healthy named snack everyday (separate to lunchbox)

You can help your child to succeed by doing the following:

- Talking to them about their day
- Encouraging putting on shoes and socks, also other items of clothing independently
- Sharing books together daily
- Encouraging independence when your child enters the classroom to put their belongings away and self-register
- Going out to the park, woods and beaches
- Exploring the changing seasons by going out for a walk and noticing changes from the last time you were out and about
