Welcome to our latest newsletter with information about events coming up before the end of term and class teachers for the next academic year.

Flipped Parents Evenings:

It was so lovely to see so many of you last week as you attended the flipped parent's evening sessions. It was clear the pupils from Year 1 to Year 6 were enthusiastic and very capable of and articulate in sharing their progress in learning and their favourite moments with you. It was a joy to listen in and observe some of the sessions. I know from feedback that this opportunity was valued by all whom attended.

Sports Day:

You will have received a letter with regard to Sports Day this week which includes information about the team colour your child is in for this year's event. The timings will also have been shared with you. These are as follows:

EYFS – Nursery and Reception classes: 9.00-9.45am

Key Stage One – Year 1 and Year 2 classes: 10.15-11.30am

Key Stage Two – Years 3 – 6 classes: 1.15-3.00pm

As you may be aware, there are roadworks taking place on La Rue de Patier in the coming weeks and this will affect traffic flow around the school. Wherever possible, we are recommending families coming along to Sports Day, walk to school.

On Sports Day, we will have staff from the Department for Infrastructure at school, displaying proposals and talking to families about the proposals to develop a safer route to our school (this is proposed to commence next summer). Please see details below.

Safe Routes to School:

As part of the Infrastructure Department's 'Safe Routes to School' programme, there are proposals to achieve a number of core road safety and highway improvement goals to encourage walking and cycling in and around schools. This has worked well around other schools in St Saviour by reducing daily conflicts between people and traffic and has led to traffic flow improvements in the area. This is something which we would welcome for the safety of our pupils.

The proposal that is related to our school features the following plans:

1. Roadside parking buffer zone (1m) to increase the safety of school drop off and pick up
2. A Puffin crossing opposite the school's main entrance
3. Improved access to the local bus stop
4. A shared field path (3m wide) between Le Clos Paumelle and La Rue de la Retraite (scope to extend in future)
5. Increased visibility at the junction of La Rue de Patier
6. Enhanced pedestrian courtesy crossings either side of the junction of La Rue de Patier
7. HGV unloading bay to support safe school meal delivery
8. Improved street lighting
9. The design mitigates changes to landscape minimising land use, preserving older trees and replacing others with semi-mature planting.

Photographs will be available to view on Sports Day and will be kept in the school entrance before moving to the Parish Hall before the end of term. Staff from the Infrastructure Department will be around to share, discuss and answer any queries.
