School Uniform from Autumn 2025

Nursery and Reception (EYFS) pupils
White or burgundy polo shirt Black leggings, jogging bottoms, skirt or shorts Burgundy school sweatshirt with school logo on
Key Stage 1 and 2 pupils
Burgundy polo shirt with school logo Burgundy cardigan, sweatshirt or fleece with school logo Black trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore Red and white checked dresses may be worn in warmer weather
Reception, Key Stage 1 and 2 pupils - PE kit
Black shorts, jogging bottoms, skirts or leggings White school logo t-shirt or school logo polo shirt School logo sports top (quarter zip) Black or mainly white trainers (not brightly coloured)
Additional clothing items – whole school
Socks/tights for all pupils should be black, grey, white or burgundy. School shoes should be black. Sun hats are to be worn in the Summer Term and first half of the Autumn Term for sun safety (school caps and legionnaire style available at uniform stockist)
Additional items, not clothing – whole school
Bookbags and lunchboxes should be all each child needs for a day at school – please avoid sending in any other bags or rucksacks as they are unnecessary and we do not have capacity to store them due to fire regulations. Watches and plain stud earrings are the only jewellery allowed – for health and safety reasons. Hair accessories to be hair coloured or school uniform colours please We ask that nail polish and tattoos are saved for the weekends, special days and holidays.

School uniform is available from Lyndale Sports Trinity. You can order online through their website www.lyndalesports.com, items are delivered free-of-charge to school.
